## SOA'S INTRODUCTORY & MANAGERIAL ACCOUNTING SUBCOMMITTEE

OBJECTIVE: The Introductory and Managerial Subcommittee of the Curriculum Committee oversees the introductory accounting, managerial accounting, and accounting information systems (AIS) curriculum within the SOA.

SUBCOMMITTEE MEMBERS: The subcommittee consists of all accounting professors teaching introductory accounting, managerial accounting, AIS and at least one other tenured accounting professor.

## **CONTINUING ACTIVITIES:**

- 1) The subcommittee reviews the content of introductory and managerial accounting and AIS courses.
- 2) The subcommittee has general oversight over the following SOA objective:

To provide students with an understanding of the organization of the accounting profession, its ethics and responsibilities, and the impact of government and other organizations on current and emerging accounting issues.

## Responsibilities for the Chair:

- 1) Call a minimum of one meeting every year; prepare an agenda for the meeting; and have a secretary take minutes of the meeting.
- 2) Maintain a file of records and correspondence, surrendering this file to the succeeding subcommittee chair at the conclusion of the term.
- 3) Submit to the Director upon request, a year-end committee report.
